Non-members (min. 12 € surcharge according to hut and tariff regulations).

The rates per night include any AV-specific taxes, service charges, add-ons and baggage insurance. When paying, the hut host will issue a receipt, which also serves as proof of luggage insurance.

The tourist tax/local tax may be charged separately.

The youth rate is also applicable to youth leaders/teamers with valid youth leader card or in the case of the DAV, with a valid annual stamp.

Reservations for overnight stays are made regardless of whether the guest wishes to take up the food service offer (e.g. Half-board).

Reduced rates and other benefits are only granted to alpine club members with valid member's card.





Equal treatment is granted to all members of alpine clubs with the respective logo and/or the respective Austrian logo on their member's card.



Free accommodation

Free accommodation is granted to alpine rescue organization members on duty as well as, according to the rule "5 + 1", to ÖAV, DAV and AVS guides, assistants of handicapped persons holding a handicapped ID, trainers, youth leaders and family group leaders if they can identify themselves as such and are guiding in their capacity with a group of at least five people.

Mountaineers' meals

For at least one "mountaineers' meal", members and equally treated per-sons are charged a price reduced by at least 10%, but not higher than \in 11,—. At least one vegetarian option must be offered. One non-alcoholic drink is offered which is at least 40% cheaper than beer in the same quan-tity. Only members are entitled to water for tea at \in 3,—/liter (incl. 2 cups).

Contribution to infrastructure

Self-catering only is permitted to members and equally treated persons in special self-catering areas which are defined by the section in agreement with the hut keepers. Self-catering guests are charged per person \in 2,50 (day visitors) or \in 5,— (overnight visitors) for using the hut's infrastructure. Alcoholic beverages brought along are generally forbidden. Children and young people up to the age of 17 are exempt from paying
